

# BTC Assessors

Can you answer yes to these questions?

1. Do you have a wide range of knowledge and experience in your area of testing?
2. Do you have an interest in helping your colleagues to develop to their full potential?
3. Do you want to further your own career by taking on some responsibility for helping others to develop?

Then you should become a BTC Assessor for your Company.

## **What is a BTC Assessor?**

A BTC Assessor is an experienced person approved by the BTC Technician Training Initiative group to assess the work of Candidates against the requirements of the Awards and to guide those Candidates to successful completion of the Awards.

## **What does an Assessor do?**

The Assessor observes and guides the Candidate as he/she works on the various Modules. Using their knowledge and experience they review the information provided by the Candidate against the requirements for the various Modules and offers advice where needed.

## **What knowledge and experience do I need to become an Assessor for the BTC Awards?**

Assessors are most likely to have significant experience in the areas they are assessing. In addition to the core engineering skills of the subject, they should also have some knowledge of risk assessments, project management and quality systems.

## **How do I become an Assessor?**

After receiving approval from your Company, complete and submit the Assessor Registration Form to the BTC Secretariat for review by the BTC TTI Group. When accepted as an Assessor you will be invited to attend the next Assessor Workshop where you will receive instruction and guidance about the Assessor's role and responsibilities.

## **What are the rewards?**

As a BTC Assessor you will have the satisfaction of knowing that you are helping your company and your colleagues to realise their full potential. From a personal point of view you will be taking on some additional responsibility and demonstrating your supervisory capabilities and will improve your own job satisfaction.
